



Addendum/Clarifications

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF FIVE UNITS OF COMMERCIAL-GRADE BANKNOTE COUNTING MACHINES FOR THE BANK

We refer to the RFP for the “*supply, installation and commissioning of five units of commercial-grade banknote counting machines*”, launched on 6 May 2026.

Further to the queries raised by a potential bidder, the responses of the Bank are as follows:

SN	Query	Response
1	As per Clause 2 (a) of the Request for Proposal, “ <i>Prices should be quoted in Mauritian Rupees only.</i> ” Can the offer be proposed in USD.	The invitation to bid has been requested from eligible local and qualified Bidders. Therefore, the offer should be made in Mauritian Rupees only.
2	Page 4 of the RFP: General Requirements: Dedicated single currency machine in MUR is specified for 2 stacker + 1 machines, but on page 5, for 1 stacker + reject, multi-currency is required. Please specify the currencies required for machine with 1 stacker + reject?	MUR, USD, Euro and GBP (any other currencies would be an advantage)
3	Bank to confirm which foreign currencies will be required for adaptation.	USD, EURO and GBP
4	Duration and likelihood of the demo to be requested by the Bank.	The duration of the demo may be tentatively for 5 working days. However, the demo will depend on the number of machine(s) being presented and their respective functionalities.
