

## Bank loans to private sector<sup>1</sup>: February 2021

Bank loans to the private sector (excluding GBCs) rose by Rs2.3 billion or 0.7 per cent, from Rs323.9 billion as at end-January 2021 to Rs326.2 billion as at end-February 2021. Inclusive of the GBC sector, bank loans dropped by Rs9.2 billion or 2.3 per cent, from Rs396.8 billion to Rs387.6 billion over the corresponding period.

Bank lending to the 'Other Nonfinancial Corporations' sector went up in February 2021, mainly reflecting increases in the following sectors: 'Administrative and support service activities' (Rs2.3 billion or 46.5 per cent), 'Accommodation and food service activities' (Rs0.9 billion or 1.8 per cent), 'Real Estate activities' (Rs0.6 billion or 3.5 per cent) and 'Construction' (Rs0.4 billion or 2.0 per cent).

The annual growth rate of bank loans to the private sector (excluding GBCs) edged down from 5.1 per cent in January 2021 to 5.0 per cent in February 2021. Annual growth in bank loans was mainly supported by the 'Accommodation and food service activities', 'Households', 'Real estate activities' and 'Administrative and support service activities' sectors.
