

## Bank loans to private sector<sup>1</sup>: October 2020

Bank loans to the private sector (excluding GBCs) rose by Rs1.6 billion or 0.5 per cent, from Rs312.1 billion as at end-September 2020 to Rs313.7 billion as at end-October 2020. Inclusive of the GBC sector, bank loans, however, decreased by Rs0.6 billion or 0.2 per cent, from Rs388.7 billion to Rs388.1 billion over the corresponding period.

The following sectors accounted for the month-on-month increase in bank loans: 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' (Rs0.7 billion or 5.5 per cent), 'Accommodation and food service activities' (Rs0.5 billion or 1.2 per cent), 'Real Estate Activities' (Rs0.3 billion or 1.4 per cent) and 'Manufacturing' (Rs0.1 billion or 0.7 per cent).

The annual growth rate of bank loans to the private sector (excluding GBCs) went up from 0.9 per cent in September 2020 to 1.8 per cent in October 2020. Annual growth in bank loans was mainly supported by the 'Accommodation and food service activities', 'Households', 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' and 'Real estate activities' sectors.
