MR ANIL GUJADHUR

Former Deputy Governor - Bank of Mauritius

Mr Anil Gujadhur spent his whole career in central banking and finance. He was respectively Assistant Director- Research Department in 1996, Director- Banking Supervision of Bank of Mauritius in 1997, Managing Director of Bank of Mauritius in 1998 and Deputy Governor in 2004.

Mr Gujadhur's experience spans over various aspects of banking and financial system development including financial system supervision and regulation for the banking industry as well as non-banking financial institutions carrying out insurance, securities market or global business activities. He has also been involved in major legislative changes pertaining to central banking, commercial banking and financial services.

Mr Anil Gujadhur was the first Chairman of the Financial Services Commission. He has been closely associated with the expansion of the financial system in the region in his capacity as chairman of the Eastern and Southern Africa (ESAF) Group of banking supervisors from 1999 to 2002.

Anil Gujadhur holds a postgraduate degree from the Delhi School of Economics and has a Banking Diploma from the Chartered Institute of Bankers (London).
