MR MITRAJEET DHANESWAR MARAYE Former Governor - Bank of Mauritius

Mr Mitrajeet Maraye was Governor of the Bank of Mauritius from April 1996 to November 1998. He is the Managing Director of Urban Infrastructure Capital Advisors, Mauritius since January 2008.

After successfully completing his secondary education at the New Eton College, he took employment as a secondary school teacher at the Eden College. Simultaneously, he enrolled as a student at the University of Mauritius for higher studies in 1968.

In 1971, Mr Maraye left Mauritius to pursue further studies in London. He then joined a firm of Chartered Accountants in April 1972 until he returned to Mauritius in December 1975. He was admitted Associate of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) in 1976 and was awarded Fellowship of the ACCA in 1982.

Mr Maraye has held several senior appointments in key organisations in Mauritius namely: the University of Mauritius, the Central Water Authority, the Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation, the National Transport Corporation, the Overseas Telecommunication Services Mauritius and the Mauritius Cooperative Central Bank Limited. He left Mauritius in 1992 to take up employment at the University of Abertay Dundee Scotland.

Mr Maraye is married, with three children and five grandchildren.
