Former Second Deputy Governor - Bank of Mauritius

Mr Issa Mohamad Soormally was appointed Second Deputy Governor of the Bank of Mauritius by the President of the Republic on 20 September 2013.

During his tenure, Mr Soormally successfully drove the bank's expansion strategy, creating synergy across the different business segments. He also revisited the operations of the bank to increase its efficiency and improve internal control measures whilst enhancing Customer Service experience. Additionally, Mr Soormally acted as the alternate director to the CEO on the board of the Mauritius Bankers Association.

Prior to joining the central bank, Mr Soormally held various positions with the BNP Paribas, Barclays Bank and Bramer Banking Corporation Ltd. He has an international track record in France, Luxembourg, Reunion Island, Dubai, Kenya and South Africa. His latest position before being appointed Second Deputy Governor was Senior Vice President responsible for the sales distribution channel at the Bramer Banking Corporation Ltd, a post he has held since August 2008.
