### **DR AHMAD JAMEEL KHADAROO**

#### **Former Second Deputy Governor, Bank of Mauritius**

Dr Khadaroo was the Second Deputy Governor of the Bank of Mauritius from February 2007 to February 2010.

He was previously at the University of Mauritius as Lecturer from 2000 to 2004 and as Senior Lecturer onwards. His research interests include econometric modelling of stock returns, inflation, exchange rates and labour market microeconomic analysis. Dr Khadaroo is the author of numerous papers and has published in a number of international journals. He has been a Consultant to the World Bank, Commonwealth Secretariat and the UNDP on issues pertaining to the Mauritian economy.

Dr Khadaroo is currently Associate Professor of Economics in the Department of Economics and Statistics of the University of Mauritius. He is also a Board Director of SBM Holdings Ltd. He is the Chairman of the SBM Holdings Risk Committee and also sits in the Regional Expansion, Audit, Strategy and IT Board Committees set up by SBM holdings

Born in 1972, Dr Khadaroo studied at Macquarie University, Australia, and at the University of Bristol, UK, where he gained both his Masters in Economics and Econometrics and his PhD in Applied Econometrics.
