MR RUNDHEERSING BHEENICK

Former Governor - Bank of Mauritius

Mr Rundheersing Bheenick was appointed Governor of the Bank of Mauritius in February 2007. His first term of office expired on 14 February 2010. He was reappointed Governor for a second term from 21 May 2010 to December 2014.

Mr Bheenick has had a long and rich international career. He was the Director-General, Ministry of Economic Planning and Development, Port-Louis, Mauritius, February 1980 – October 1995 and was elected Member of Parliament (MP), December 1995 - September 2000. As MP he occupied the positions of Minister of Economic Development, Productivity and Regional Co-operation from July 1997 to September 2000, and that of Minister of Finance from December 1995 to August 1996.

Mr Bheenick has also been the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Indian Ocean Rim Association for Regional Co-operation, 1997-1999 and Chairman of the COMESA Council of Ministers, 2000. He is the author of various papers and publications. In December 2011, he was designated Central Banker of the Year 2012, Africa by The Banker Magazine of the Financial Times Publications of UK.

Mr Bheenick, a laureate from the Royal College, Port-Louis, studied at Merton College, Oxford, Honour School of Philosophy, Politics and Economics and is the holder of a M.A. (Oxon).
