



Central Bank Survey: End-April 2026

The monetary base stood at Rs203,852 million at the end of April 2026. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs99,558 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs395,598 million and Rs60,990 million, respectively.
