



Central Bank Survey: End-August 2026

The monetary base stood at Rs203,421 million at the end of August 2026. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs98,341 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs418,461 million and Rs54,019 million, respectively.
