



Central Bank Survey: End-July 2026

The monetary base stood at Rs205,603 million at the end of July 2026. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs100,536 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs396,494 million and Rs60,291 million, respectively.
