



Central Bank Survey: End-May 2026

The monetary base stood at Rs204,457 million at the end of May 2026. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs100,449 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs403,266 million and Rs61,293 million, respectively.
