

Central Bank Survey: End-April 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs168,634 million at the end of April 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs83,962 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs238,065 million and Rs73,896 million, respectively.
