

Central Bank Survey: End-August 2017

The monetary base declined by Rs3,193 million, from Rs82,261 million as at end-July 2017 to Rs79,068 million as at end-August 2017, or by 3.9 per cent, as against an increase of 1.9 per cent registered between end-June 2017 and end-July 2017. The fall in the monetary base reflected decreases in all of its components. Year-on-year, the monetary base grew at a slower pace of 9.4 per cent in August 2017 compared to 14.6 per cent in July 2017.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went down by Rs407 million, or 0.2 per cent to Rs175,785 million as at end-August 2017. Net Claims on Central Government fell by Rs1,457 million, from negative Rs27,482 million as at end-July 2017 to negative Rs28,939 million as at end-August 2017.
