

Central Bank Survey: End-August 2022

The monetary base stood at Rs216,751 million at the end of August 2022. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs132,815 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs264,594 million and Rs69,336 million, respectively.
