

## **Central Bank Survey: End-August 2023**

The monetary base stood at Rs162,275 million at the end of August 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs78,241 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs253,005 million and Rs79,314 million, respectively.
