

Central Bank Survey: End-December 2022

The monetary base stood at Rs248,164 million at the end of December 2022. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs160,738 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs290,734 million and Rs71,987 million, respectively.
