



Central Bank Survey: End-December 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs203,066 million at the end of December 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs96,669 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs406,548 million and Rs61,217 million, respectively.
