



Central Bank Survey: End-February 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs186,320 million at the end of February 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs101,088 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs251,346 million and Rs79,613 million, respectively.
