

Central Bank Survey: End-January 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs183,303 million at the end of January 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs97,771 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs251,591 million and Rs72,368 million, respectively.
