

Central Bank Survey: End-July 2018

The monetary base dropped by Rs8,389 million, from Rs109,049 million as at end-June 2018 to Rs100,660 million as at end-July 2018, or by 7.7 per cent, as against a rise of 9.8 per cent recorded between end-May 2018 and end-June 2018. The contraction in the monetary base resulted mostly from the fall in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. The annual growth rate of monetary base slowed from 35.1 per cent in June 2018 to 22.4 per cent in July 2018.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank declined by Rs8,317 million, or by 3.6 per cent to Rs221,922 million as at end-July 2018. Net Claims on Central Government went down by Rs3,037 million, or by 13.7 per cent to negative Rs25,283 million as at end-July 2018.
