

Central Bank Survey: End-July 2016

The monetary base went up by Rs1,391 million or 2.0 per cent, from Rs70,420 million at end-June 2016 to Rs71,811 million at end-July 2016 as against a fall of 7.4 per cent registered between end-May 2016 and end-June 2016. The increase in the monetary base reflected the rise in liabilities to other depository corporations and currency in circulation. The annual growth rate of monetary base accelerated by 4.4 per cent in July 2016 as against a contraction of 1.6 per cent in June 2016.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank rose by Rs185 million or 0.1 per cent, from Rs166,726 million as at end-June 2016 to Rs166,911 million as at end-July 2016. Net Claims on Central Government went up by Rs130 million, from negative Rs35,913 million at end-June 2016 to negative Rs35,783 million at end-July 2016.
