

Central Bank Survey: End-July 2019

The monetary base went up by Rs4,123 million, from Rs105,730 million as at end-June 2019 to Rs109,853 million as at end-July 2019, or by 3.9 per cent, as against a decrease of 2.6 per cent registered between end-May 2019 and end-June 2019. The expansion in the monetary base resulted mostly from the rise in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. The annual growth rate of monetary base rose from -3.0 per cent in June 2019 to 9.1 per cent in July 2019.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs6,007 million, or by 2.4 per cent to Rs258,965 million as at end-July 2019. Net Claims on Central Government rose by Rs69 million, or by 0.4 per cent to negative Rs18,377 million as at end-July 2019.
