

Central Bank Survey: End-July 2022

The monetary base stood at Rs215,275 million at the end of July 2022. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs131,013 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs264,077 million and Rs71,505 million, respectively.
