



Central Bank Survey: End-July 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs162,584 million at the end of July 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs78,709 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs243,013 million and Rs75,509 million, respectively.
