



Central Bank Survey: End-June 2018

The monetary base expanded by Rs9,693 million, from Rs99,356 million as at end-May 2018 to Rs109,049 million as at end-June 2018, or by 9.8 per cent, compared to a rise of 2.7 per cent registered between end-April 2018 and end-May 2018. The expansion in the monetary base resulted mostly from the increase in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. The annual growth rate of monetary base accelerated from 18.4 per cent in May 2018 to 35.1 per cent in June 2018.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs8,297 million, or by 3.7 per cent to Rs230,239 million as at end-June 2018. Net Claims on Central Government went down by Rs3,672 million, from negative Rs18,574 million as at end-May 2018 to negative Rs22,246 million as at end-June 2018.
