

Central Bank Survey: End-June 2019

The monetary base contracted by Rs2,801 million, from Rs108,531 million as at end-May 2019 to Rs105,730 million as at end-June 2019, or by 2.6 per cent, as against an increase of 4.8 per cent registered between end-April 2019 and end-May 2019. The fall in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations contributed mostly to the decrease in the monetary base. The annual growth rate of monetary base decelerated from 9.2 per cent in May 2019 to -3.0 per cent in June 2019.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs12,550 million, or by 5.2 per cent to Rs252,958 million as at end-June 2019. Net Claims on Central Government rose by Rs2,754 million, or by 13.0 per cent to negative Rs18,446 million as at end-June 2019.
