

Central Bank Survey: End-June 2020

The monetary base decreased by Rs8,504 million, from Rs156,851 million at the end of May 2020 to Rs148,347 million at the end of June 2020, or by 5.4 per cent, as against an increase of 18.5 per cent registered between end-April 2020 and end-May 2020. The contraction in the monetary base largely reflected the decrease in liabilities to other depository corporations. The annual growth rate of the monetary base fell from 44.5 per cent in May 2020 to 40.3 per cent in June 2020.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank rose by Rs3,344 million or 1.2 per cent to Rs278,884 million at the end of June 2020. Net Claims on Central Government fell by Rs23,153 million from Rs1,026 million at end-May 2020 to negative Rs22,127 million at end-June 2020.
