

Central Bank Survey: End-June 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs161,340 million at the end of June 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs77,510 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs242,383 million and Rs70,921 million, respectively.
