

Central Bank Survey: End-June 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs189,382 million at the end of June 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs95,279 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs375,291 million and Rs69,252 million, respectively.
