



Central Bank Survey: End-March 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs174,827 million at the end of March 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs89,898 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs252,716 million and Rs75,159 million, respectively.
