



Central Bank Survey: End-March 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs169,005 million at the end of March 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs81,971 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs273,244 million and Rs83,483 million, respectively.
