

Central Bank Survey: End-March 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs181,918 million at the end of March 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs87,518 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs338,405 million and Rs73,711 million, respectively.
