



Central Bank Survey: End-May 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs163,148 million at the end of May 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs78,691 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs238,131 million and Rs69,482 million, respectively.
