



Central Bank Survey: End-May 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs182,178 million at the end of May 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs87,717 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs340,815 million and Rs74,197 million, respectively.
