



Central Bank Survey: End-November 2021

The monetary base rose by Rs1,991 million, or 0.8 per cent, from Rs248,055 million at the end of October 2021 to Rs250,046 million at the end of November 2021, as against a decrease of 4.4 per cent registered between end-September 2021 and end-October 2021. The rise in the monetary base mainly reflected increases in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations and currency in circulation, which more than offset the fall in liabilities to other sectors. The annual growth rate of the monetary base dropped from 39.3 per cent in October 2021 to 35.7 per cent in November 2021.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs1,999 million, or 0.7 per cent, to Rs300,725 million at the end of November 2021. Net Claims on Central Government fell by Rs1,930 million to negative Rs21,044 million at end-November 2021.
