

Central Bank Survey: End-November 2022

The monetary base stood at Rs177,765 million at the end of November 2022. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs94,664 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs243,315 million and Rs65,058 million, respectively.
