

Central Bank Survey: End-October 2018

The monetary base declined by Rs1,663 million, from Rs99,760 million as at end-September 2018 to Rs98,097 million as at end-October 2018, or by 1.7 per cent, compared to a decrease of 11.7 per cent registered between end-August 2018 and end-September 2018. The drop in the monetary base resulted mostly from the fall in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. However, the annual growth rate of monetary base went up from 16.1 per cent in September 2018 to 18.5 per cent in October 2018.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank fell by Rs1,275 million, or by 0.6 per cent to Rs217,596 million as at end-October 2018. Net Claims on Central Government rose by Rs568 million, or by 2.5 per cent to negative Rs22,390 million as at end-October 2018.
