

## **Central Bank Survey: End-October 2019**

The monetary base went down by Rs1,127 million, from Rs105,738 million as at end-September 2019 to Rs104,611 million as at end-October 2019, or by 1.1 per cent, as against an increase of 1.0 per cent recorded between end-August 2019 and end-September 2019. The drop in the monetary base resulted mostly from the decrease in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. Year-on-year, the monetary base expanded by 6.6 per cent in October 2019, higher than the increase of 6.0 per cent in September 2019.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs681 million, or by 0.3 per cent to Rs263,443 million as at end-October 2019. Net Claims on Central Government rose by Rs1,321 million, or by 6.8 per cent to negative Rs18,081 million as at end-October 2019.
