

Central Bank Survey: End-October 2022

The monetary base stood at Rs188,928 million at the end of October 2022. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs105,340 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs235,415 million and Rs71,225 million, respectively.
