

Central Bank Survey: End-September 2017

The monetary base went up by Rs6,862 million, from Rs79,068 million as at end-August 2017 to Rs85,930 million as at end-September 2017, or by 8.7 per cent, as against a contraction of 3.9 per cent recorded between end-July 2017 and end-August 2017. The expansion in the monetary base resulted from the increases in all of its components. Year-on-year, the monetary base accelerated to 17.6 per cent in September 2017, from 9.4 per cent in August 2017.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank rose by Rs9,273 million, or 5.3 per cent to Rs185,058 million as at end-September 2017. Net Claims on Central Government went up by Rs2,804 million, from negative Rs28,939 million as at end-August 2017 to negative Rs26,135 million as at end-September 2017.
