

Central Bank Survey: End-September 2019

The monetary base increased by Rs1,016 million, from Rs104,722 million as at end-August 2019 to Rs105,738 million as at end-September 2019, or by 1.0 per cent, as against a decrease of 4.7 per cent registered between end-July 2019 and end-August 2019. The rise in the monetary base resulted mostly from the increase in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. On a year-on-year basis, the monetary base expanded by 6.0 per cent in September 2019 as against a contraction of 7.3 per cent in August 2019.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank went up by Rs3,334 million, or by 1.3 per cent to Rs262,762 million as at end-September 2019. Net Claims on Central Government increased by Rs2,225 million, or by 10.3 per cent to negative Rs19,402 million as at end-September 2019.
