

Central Bank Survey: End-September 2021

The monetary base expanded by Rs17,790 million or 7.4 per cent, from Rs241,689 million at the end of August 2021 to Rs259,478 million at the end of September 2021, as against a decrease of 0.6 per cent registered between end-July 2021 and end-August 2021. The expansion in the monetary base mainly reflected the increase in liabilities to Other Depository Corporations. The annual growth rate of the monetary base rose from 75.8 per cent in August 2021 to 90.9 per cent in September 2021.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets of the Bank rose by Rs2,170 million or 0.7 per cent to Rs313,225 million at the end of September 2021. Net Claims on Central Government rose by Rs2,331 million to negative Rs39,464 million at end-September 2021.
