

Central Bank Survey: End-September 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs163,024 million at the end of September 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs79,602 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs229,918 million and Rs82,280 million, respectively.
