



## Gross Official International Reserves: End-September 2022

The Gross Official International Reserves (GOIR) of the country amounted to Rs329.1 billion (equivalent to USD7,336.1 million) as at end-September 2022. Based on the imports of goods and services for calendar year 2021, the GOIR represented 15.5 months of imports as at end-September 2022.
