



REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Supply and Installation of Two (2) New Chiller Systems and Associated Works at the Bank of Mauritius

1. The Bank of Mauritius ('Bank') invites sealed bids from eligible firms for the Project "Supply, installation and commissioning of two (2) Air-Cooled Screw Chiller Systems (Chillers) each having a Cooling Capacity of 1,200 kW and Associated Works" at its Tower Building, situate at Sir William Newton Street, Port-Louis.
2. A mandatory site visit will be held on 04 February 2020 at 11h00 for prospective bidders to take cognizance of the scope of work and the location where the Chiller Systems will be installed.
3. Prospective bidders are requested to confirm their attendance to the site visit by calling the Bank's Receptionist on 202 3800 no later than 14h00 on 03 February 2020.
4. The Scope of Work of the Project and Financial Bid Sheet will be available at the Reception Desk of the Bank, Ground Floor of the Tower Building.
5. The Project shall be executed and completed within 21 Weeks.

7. The Bank reserves the right to appoint one or more contractors to perform the above work.

 - (ii) Electronic bidding shall not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected.
