

GOVERNMENT OF MAURITIUS TREASURY BILLS

30 June 2021

Further to the Advance Notice published on 23 June 2021, the Bank will issue on **Friday 2 July 2021** Government of Mauritius Treasury Bills (GMTBs) in the 91-Day tenor.

2. The Bank will receive bids from Primary Dealers for the 91-Day Government of Mauritius Treasury Bills (GMTBs) for a nominal amount of Rs1,000 million, to be sold through auction, in multiples of Rs100,000, on a yield basis quoted to two decimal places on **Friday 2 July 2021** for same day settlement.

3. Primary Dealers shall submit bids for the GMTBs, up to a maximum of **three** bids, one for each bid yield, which, however, should not exceed the tender amount in the aggregate.

4. Bids must be submitted **before 10.00 a.m. on Friday 2 July 2021**. Bids received after the prescribed time and date shall not be considered.

5. In the event of oversubscription, the Bank may accept a higher amount than the amount put on tender.

6. Results of the auction will be announced on the same day and successful bidders will be required to effect payment of the cost price of the GMTBs through the Mauritius Automated Clearing and Settlement System, at latest by 1.00 p.m. on the same day, i.e., on **Friday 2 July 2021**.

7. The Bank of Mauritius reserves the right to accept or reject any bid either in full or in part, without assigning any reason in respect thereof.
